## **St Bryce Café**

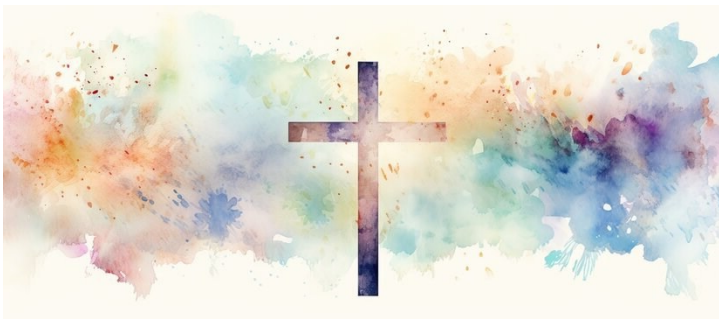
If you would be interested in volunteering please come in and have a chat with Kara or Rosalind at the office.
